The detergent maintains the factory-applied treatment longer (termed Durable Water Repellent, DWR) and leaves no residue that impairs a garment's breathability or water-repellent function. If necessary, when the DWR has been washed out or worn away and water no longer beads on the outer fabric, re-waterproofing with OrganoTex® Wash-In or Spray-On is recommended. Taking good care of your functional garments makes them last longer.

### Applications

Suitable for shell garments, padded ski clothing, rain clothing, synthetic outerwear, fleece clothing, backpacks, etc. Also works in cold water and is therefore ideal for mountain hikes.

### Sustainability

The product is readily biodegradable, highly concentrated, highly biobased and PFAS-free.

### Contents

15–30% soap, 5–15% non-ionic surfactants, 1–5% anionic surfactants, <1% preservatives, (2-phenoxyethanol), enzymes.

### How to use

- 1) Shake the bottle. Make sure the detergent compartment is clean.
- 2) Add 30 ml (soft water) or 40 ml (hard water) into the detergent compartment for up to 3 items or 4–5 kg of laundry. Do not use fabric softener!
- 3) Wash and dry according to care instructions.

Hand wash: use ca. 20 ml for 10 litres of water. Allow to stand for a while and then rinse thoroughly. Also usable in cold water.

### Safety

### Other information

Coverage: Sufficient for about 16 washes. Shelf life: 24 months, opened packaging. Storage: Frost-free, out of reach of children. Recycling: Sorted as plastic (rPET bottle).
